


#### \$5+ TRILLION IN FUNDING IN 12 MONTHS

- American Rescue Plan \$1.9T
- Consolidated Appropriations Act \$868B
- Paycheck Protection Program and Health Care Enhancement Act \$483B
- The Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act \$2T
- Families First Coronavirus Response Act \$192B
- Coronavirus Preparedness and Response Supplemental Appropriations Act - \$8B

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COVID-19 RELATED
Reasonably necessary expenditures incurred due to the public health emergency with respect to COVID-19.

NOT BUDGETED
Expenditures were not accounted for in the budget most recently approved as of March 27, 2020.

SINCURRED DURING 2021
Costs were incurred during the period that begins on March 1, 2020 and ends on December 30, 2021 (extended deadline).


