

Well-Being Scores

- Well-Being Score at **22 points (lowest)**. Households qualify for SNAP and OWF.
 - *Homeless*
 - *No transportation*
 - *Have debt and not paying*
 - *No Savings*
 - *No high school diploma/GED and job training*
 - *No employment*
- Well-Being Score at **50 points**. Households have left OWF and qualify for reduced SNAP.
 - Subsidized housing
 - Available transportation but not always reliable
 - Have debt and behind in payments
 - Little savings to handle a crisis
 - High school diploma/GED and some job training
- Well-Being Score at **80 points**. Most all households leave SNAP.
 - Stable housing and not subsidized
 - Mostly reliable transportation
 - Current in all debt payments
 - Some savings to handle a crisis
 - Associate's degree or professional certification
- Well-Being Score at **110 points (highest)**. No households qualify for SNAP.
 - Stable housing, not subsidized, and cost is less than 1/3rd income
 - Reliable transportation
 - No debt
 - Savings to handle a crisis and 3 months of expenses
 - Bachelor's degree or higher
